This letter is to inform you that you will receive your tax rate notice for 2010 by the end of March 2010, in accordance with IC 22-4-19-13(f). This is a change from the Department of Workforce Development's (DWD) past practice, and is due to new legislation introduced in the Indiana General Assembly that, if passed, will delay the changes in tax rates and taxable wage base contained in current law (HEA1379-2009).

Historically, DWD has mailed employers tax rate notices in November, allowing as much time as possible to budget and prepare for the first quarter payment, due April 30<sup>th</sup>. Due to the pending legislation currently under discussion by the General Assembly, your tax rates may change. Therefore, the department will send official tax rate notices following final legislative action, no later than the end of March.

After you receive your official rate notice near the end of March, all first quarter 2010 payments received by May 31, 2010, will have the Penalty and Interest waived. Your 2010 second quarter payments will be due as usual on July 30, 2010.

We're sorry for any inconvenience this may cause you as we await the outcome of the General Assembly session. To help you with budgeting for 2010, we have included unofficial tax rates below.

| Unofficial Tax Rates for this account       |       |                                      |
|---------------------------------------------|-------|--------------------------------------|
| Tax rate for 2010 under HEA1379:            | 0.70% | Using a Taxable Wage Base of \$9,500 |
| Tax rate if HEA1379 is delayed (as drafted) | 1.10% | Using a Taxable Wage Base of \$7,000 |
